




CoolVee 7 7 Bulb Fluorescent Light

# **Housing and Main Components**



A- Knob

B- Handle

C-Switches

D- Light Body

E-Power Socket

F- Tilt Bracket

G- Bulb

H- Reflector

I-Softbox

### **Attaching the Reflector**

If you choose to use the reflector instead of the softbox, you MUST attach the reflector before you install any bulbs. Slide the reflector so the grooves line up with the protruding screws on the light body. Twist it to lock it into position, then tighten the screws.

# **Assembling the Softbox**


1. Put the light body in flat position.




3. Insert any rod into its softbox pocket.




Then insert the opposite rod into the softbox pocket and in the light body.




2. Put softbox around the light body.




4. Insert the other end of same rod in the light body.



6. Insert the next 2 rods at a 90° angle from the first 2 rods that were inserted. One end inserted into the softbox pocket, the other into the light body.



7. Insert the remaining rods, always placing one end, then the one opposite it. Once all the rods are inserted, the softbox will assume its final shape.



Ensure all switch are OFF before continuing.




 If desired, you can put the white diffuser inside to make the light softer.



8. Close the Velcro tightly prevent light leak.



10. Screw all bulbs into the lamp holder. Only touch the base of the bulb, do not touch the glass as this can shorten the bulb life.



12. Assemble the outside diffuser tightly on the softbox edge.



14. Insert the included power cable to the back of the light head. Plug the other end into a power outlet.

13. Put the light on the light stand (5/8"stud) and lock tightly with knob. Adjust the light angle and lock the lock handle.



15. Use the switches to control how many bulbs will be used. You are now ready to shoot!





#### **Caution**

- Do not use in an environment where moisture or flammable vapor is likely to come in contact with the unit.
- Do not use a bulb which is over rated power.
- Do not change the fuse with one of a different current.
- Only qualified service engineer should access the inside of the housing.
- Only replace the bulb and fuse when the switch is off and unplugged.
- When removing the power cable, firmly grasp the connector, do not tug from a distance.
