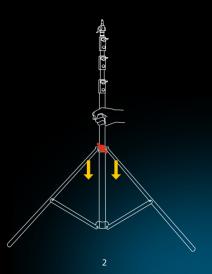
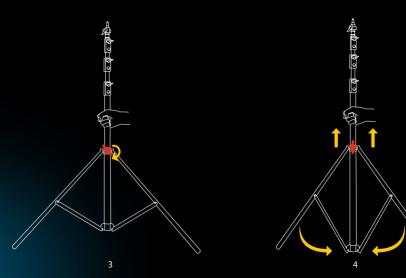


Instructions

- 1. Loosen the locking screw that controls the leg extension (at the top of where the 3 legs meet)
- 2. Extend the legs until the brake ring stops you from extending them any further
- 3. Tighten the locking screw that controls the leg extension while the legs are fully extended
- 4. Lift the stand, the legs should collapse for easy location changes
- Place the stand on a flat, hard surface, the legs should automatically extend and the base should lift off the ground
- If the floor is not smooth enough the legs may not fully extend,
 use your foot to sweep one of the legs to its fullest extension
 WHILE HOLDING THE CENTER COLUMN
- 7. To collapse the stand for packing, remove the light, then loosen the locking screw that controls the leg extension
- 8. Collapse the legs until the brake ring stops you from collapsing them any further
- 9. Tighten the locking screw







Warnings

- Only mount your lights when the legs are fully extended
- Do not subject the stand to a high center of gravity, which can cause it to tip and fall
- Use sandbags and other weights when needed
- Never tilt the stand forward or carry it tilted or horizontal when something is mounted on it, this will damage the column locks
- Misuse can result in serious damage to the stand, your lighting equipment, and bystanders and property
- Be mindful of ceiling height, do not damage the ceiling or your lights with sudden impacts
- Remember that when you lift the stand the lights go HIGHER than their current position, and keep the previous warning in mind
