

If output is too loud for your headphones or other equipment:






Saving User Presets


1. Press Save

(User Preset 01A - 31D)




3. Press Save again




4. Rename User Preset

Cabinet Tuning Mode

By default the AMP OUT is tuned for ideal sound when connected to the instrument input of an open-back guitar amplifier. If connecting to something else, you can change the Cabinet Tuning Mode.




2. **Direct Mode** - no amp or speaker cabs connected (to recording device, mixer, live P.A., etc.)
'D' Instr In Clsd - for connecting to a guitar combo/head with a closed back speaker cabinet.
'C' Instr In Open - for connecting to a guitar combo/head with an open back speaker cabinet.
'B' Pwr Amp Open - for connecting to a power amp with an open back speaker cabinet.
'A' Pwr Amp Clsd - for connecting to a power amp with a closed back speaker cabinet.
