Installation

To begin the installation process, connect the USB 2.0 Hub to an available USB 2.0 port. Software installation will commence as follows:

Windows 2000/XP

- Windows will launch the Add New Hardware Wizard. Press Next to begin the software installation process.
- 2. When the Found New Hardware Wizard appears, click Next:



Windows will then search for the driver files required for the Generic USB Hub. Click Next:



4. Windows will locate the driver file. Click OK to proceed, and follow any remaining prompts to complete installation.



- To verify that the drivers have successfully been installed, rightclick on My Computer and select Manage. Select Device Manager, and click on the [+] symbol located next to Universal Serial Bus Controllers. Here, you should notice a listing for Generic USB Hub:

Windows Vista

Windows Vista driver installation requires no interaction. Simply connect the USB Hub to an available USB port on the host computer, and wait for the Windows notification that your device is now installed.
